The following bug fixes are new in this build.		
11945242	A new toast notification is available to direct users to launch a device management app used to complete a printer installation.	
11098231	We removed the semicolon that followed the translation of the word "sync" in the Settings app on French language systems.	
11098274	We fixed the format of the translated percentage character on French language systems.	

Known issues

The following known issues are new in this build.

12096080, 12167698, 12167780	A failure may occur if a user attempts to update to the latest OS build from a previous build. Automatic update may fail repeatedly, and if a user updates a device using full flash update (FFU), the device cannot be rebooted successfully, which means they will have to reflash the device for it to work again.
12146109	On a device with a common 64-bit chip architecture, system sounds (such as from a notification) and Win32 apps that use audio are heavily distorted instead of playing clearly. However, this problem does not affect audio streams (such as audio from a common video streaming site).
9206994	A crash in Cortana or other apps may occur because of a failfast exception (0xC0000602) in the core UI components library (CoreUIComponents.dll).
